Smoke Detector Disposal

For those of you who are replacing your old IONIZATION type smoke detectors, we have been advised by Zero Waste that the proper way to dispose of them is to REMOVE the battery and dispose of it with your other batteries. The amount of radioactive material is considered to be insignificant so the rest of the smoke detector can be placed in the LANDFILL bin.

REMINDER: If you haven't filled out and returned your smoke/CO detector form to PML, please do so ASAP. We need those forms to complete the city inspection process for the reconstruction work.
