# HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

## Curbside Collection



Put used oil filters in sealed tear-resistant bags and place them next to your recycling cart.



Put motor oil in a clear, one-gallon plastic container with tight fitting, screw-top lid next to your recycling cart.



Put batteries in a sealed clear tear-resistant bag and place on top of your recycling cart.
