

Tennis Court Rules

These rules have been adopted to ensure your comfort and safety and comfort and safety of others using the Barron Square HOA Tennis Courts. Please read and follow these rules:

- The tennis court is for **RESIDENTS** and their accompanied GUESTS for playing tennis only. The tennis court may NOT be used as a playground.
- A resident must accompany guests using the tennis court. Residents are limited to three (3) quests per household.
- Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests and any damage they may cause to the tennis court.
- There is NO ADVANCE SIGN-UP ALLOWED. Use is on a first-come first-served basis only.
- When others are waiting to play, the TIME LIMIT for play is one hour and fifteen minutes. Sign-in time is required so that others coming to play will be able to determine when they will be able to play.
- Rubber-soled court shoes must be worn on the court at all times. (NOTE: the soles of some running shoes leave marks on the court surface; such shoes are prohibited.)
- GLASS OR BREAKABLE CONTAINERS are PROHIBITED inside the gate.
- Pets are NOT PERMITTED inside the tennis court at any time.
- Please use the TRASH containers for all refuse; please replace the lid.
- Be sure the gate is LOCKED when you leave the tennis court. Check for and remove your personal belongings.

Non-compliance with the rules, abuse or misuse of the facilities can result in a fine to the owner or resident or denial of access to the tennis court. Please report any abuse of these rules to PML Management or the Board.
